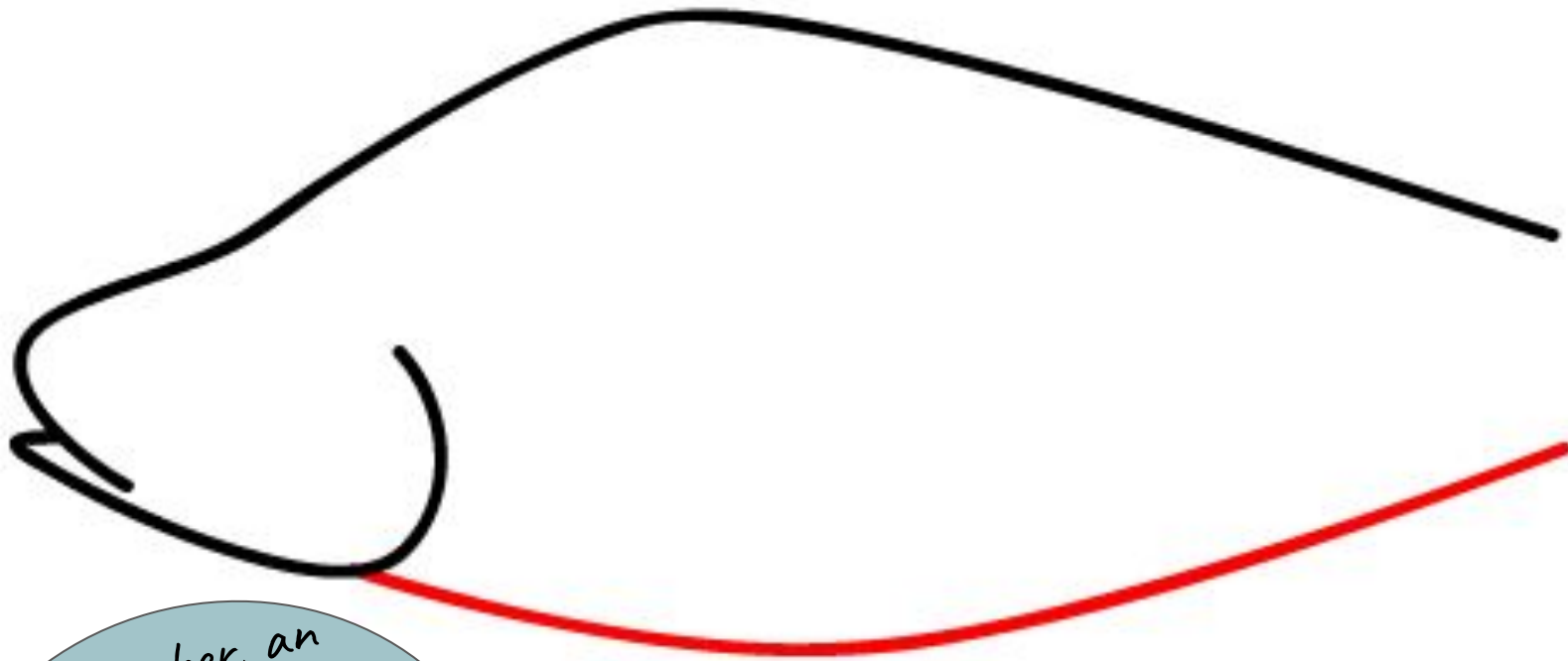


Drawing Trout Anatomy
